

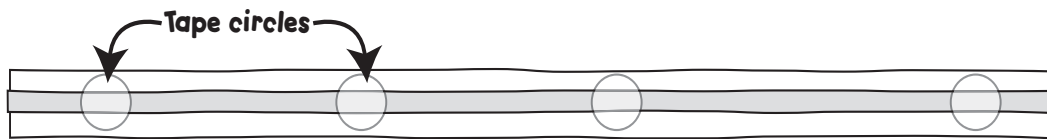


Belt Loops

Get Ready!

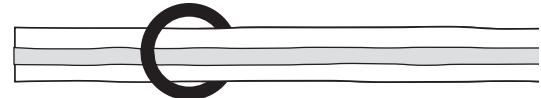
Pick out 1, 2, or 3 ribbons that you would like to use in your belt. Layer them as you like. Remember you are making **reversible** belts! So be sure to check the “back” side as this will be another style to wear!

Place a few tape circles on your ribbons to secure your layers. This will make it easier to weave!

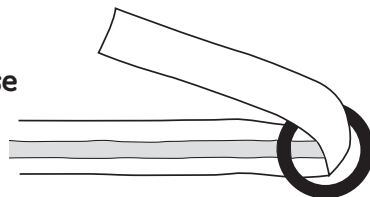


Get Set!

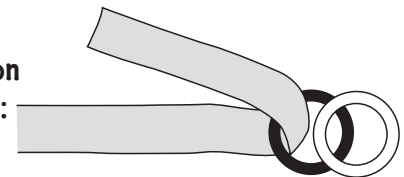
Now you're ready to weave! Find the large belt loops. String on your first loop 12" from the left of your ribbon. Make sure the loop looks like this on the ribbon:



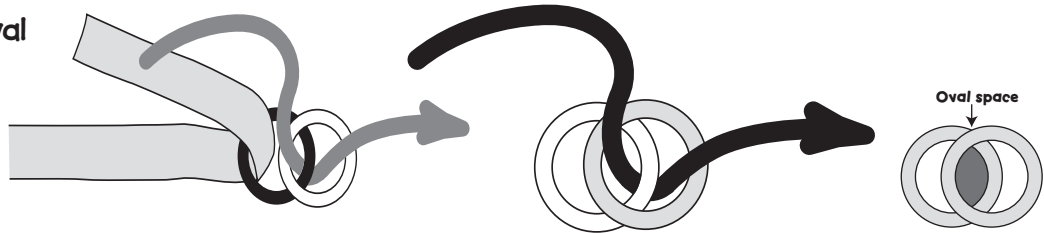
Lift up the ribbon to expose the right side of the loop:



Place another loop on top of the first loop:



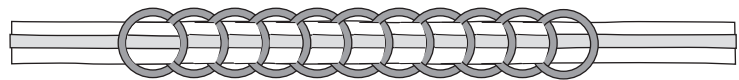
Weave the ribbon into the oval space created by the loops and out of the second loop:



Now repeat these steps:

1. Fold back the ribbon.
2. Place a new loop on top of the old loop.
3. Weave into the oval and out of the new loop.

You can space your loops in different ways to create different looks!



Go!

Now tie it around your waist! Tie your belt in a simple knot or a bow!

Wear your belt one way today, then flip it over and wear it the other way tomorrow!

Make bracelets using these same steps.

You will have to cut the ribbons to about 12" so they will fit your wrist!
