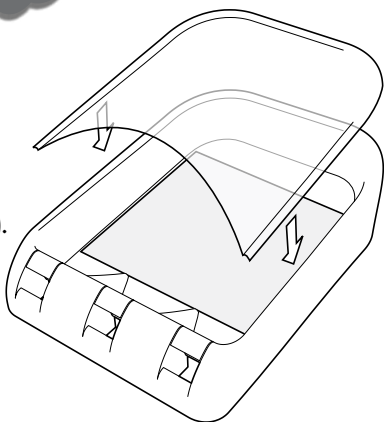


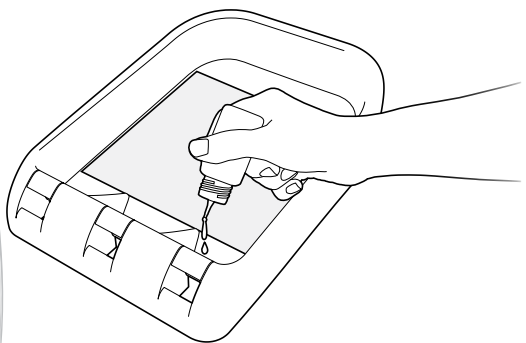
Pinball Painter

Establish a work area that is large enough for you to work comfortably. You'll need something to protect your work surface (an ALEX[®] Drop Cloth or newspaper works well).

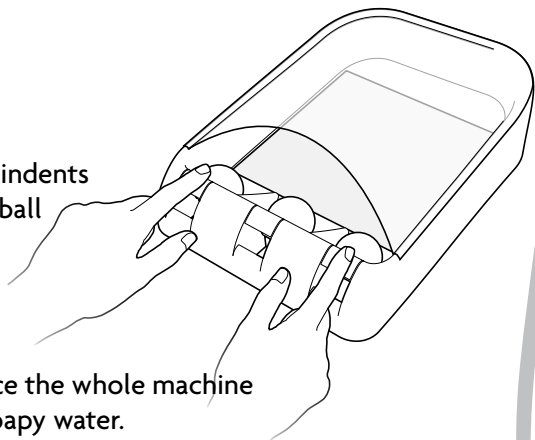
1. Place a piece of paper into the machine and put the splash guard on the machine.



2. Add paint to each of the indents. Be careful not to overfill them. The paint should just cover the bottom of the indents.



3. Put an orange ball in each of the indents and flick the flippers to create a pinball painting!



Clean up:

When you are finished painting, Place the whole machine in the sink and wash it with warm soapy water.
